Championship Tournament Rules

Entry Requirements: This is a USBC-certified singles tournament (#08222) sponsored by the Youth Bowler's Tournament Association and managed by the Ohio High School Bowling Coaches Association (OHSBCA). This tournament is open to every 9th, 10th, 11th, & 12th grade student with legal, permanent residence in the State of Ohio. ***A bowler does not have to be a member of a high school bowling team to participate in this tournament.***

Tournament Organization: These Championships will be conducted at HP Lanes, 2012 Innis Rd., Columbus, OH 43224. Phone: 614.267.0321. The 11th & 12th grade Championships will be conducted on Sunday, March 21, 2010 and the 9th & 10th grade Championships will be conducted on Sunday, March 28, 2010. Check-in for both tournaments on both dates begins at 10:00 AM. and tournament bowling begins about 11:00 A.M. This tournament will have four (4) separate divisions: high school freshman, sophomores, juniors, and seniors. Each division will have separate boy and girl sub-divisions. Bowlers will be placed in divisions based on their 2009-2010 school grade and gender. Each tournament will limit participation to the first 216 paid entries received on a 1st come-1st served basis based on the postmark date of the entry. Closing entry date for the 11th/12th grade championships is March 21, 2010. Closing entry date for the 9th/10th grade championships is March 28, 2010. Walk-in's (entries received the day of the tournament) will be allowed subject to lane availability and will be assessed a late processing fee.

Tournament Format: All bowlers in each division will bowl six (6) games of ten pin bowling, moving pairs after each game. Tournament standings in each division will be based on the total scores of the six (6) game series. There will be no step-ladder or final elimination rounds. All scoring will be conducted on a scratch (actual) basis. Ties for awards will be broken based on high game rolled in the six (6) game series. **Lane Pattern:** The oil pattern used in this tournament will be a "modified" shot identified as playing in-between a standard "house" shot and a "sport" shot. The oil pattern will be posted in the tournament office.

Entry Fee: \$60.00. Breakdown: Lineage: \$12.00. Expenses: \$20.00. SMART Scholarships: \$28.00.
Note: Optional scholarship jackpots and scholarship brackets will be available.

Awards: No fewer than 1:6 bowlers in each grade/gender division will be awarded SMART scholarships. Medals will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place bowlers in each division and sub-division. 100% of all collected scholarship funds will be awarded. The final tournament results will be posted on www.ohiohighschoolbowling.com.

Dress Code/Behavior: A collared shirt or a non-collared shirt made of dri-mesh type material is allowed. *Shirts with tails (uneven bottom) must be tucked in!* Girls may wear pants, skorts, skirts, or shorts (minimum middle finger-tip length requirement). Boys must wear long pants. No jeans, pants with outside pockets, or hats allowed. Pants must be worn at waist level and not touch the floor. The use of cell phones and any electronic devices during tournament practice/competition is not allowed. Bowlers are expected to be professional in appearance, reflecting the high caliber of tournament bowling anticipated. Abuse of equipment, foul or disruptive language/gestures, and/or misbehavior by bowlers or spectators are cause for the non-refundable dismissal from participation or attendance at this tournament. All bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of powder or any foreign substance (including Easy Slide) on shoes, the approach, or on the facility floor, tables, or carpet is not permitted. Only participating bowlers and tournament officials are permitted in the bowling area.

Empowerment: The Tournament Manager has the right to refuse any entry. The bowler, by voluntary participation in this tournament, acquiesces to the final authority of the Tournament Manager to interpret and enforce all tournament rules, regulations, and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretive judgment guided by the best interests of youth bowling and this event.

Scholarship Management: 100% of all collected scholarship funds will be awarded and sent to the USBC SMART Program for management/dispersal (Account # 11600). Information about the SMART Program is available on www.bowl.com.
